About the scholarship:

The Air Academy Federal Credit Union Foundation Scholarship offers funding to assist students in obtaining a college or university degree. Five \$1,000 Scholarships will be awarded on a competitive basis to high school seniors. All majors are accepted. Scholarship recipients are chosen based on academic merit, application questions, essay response, and community involvement. Awarded scholarships will be sent directly to the student's accredited institution. Awarded recipients must use the funds before March 2025.

Qualifications:

See the requirements below to find out if an Air Academy Federal Credit Union Foundation Scholarship is right for you.

- You are a high school senior
- A parent must be an AAFCU member **OR** must be a current AAFCU member **OR** you must be enrolled in one of the AACU qualifying school districts:

- Minimum GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
- All majors are accepted
- You are eligible to attend a 2- or 4-year college or university
- You will enroll and attend an accredited institution in the academic year after your selection.

Required documents:

- Official confirmation of GPA or written acknowledgment of GPA by school administration
- One letter of recommendation from a teacher or community member
- Completed AAFCU Foundation scholarship application
- Completed Essay
 - The essay topic is: "How will this scholarship make a difference for you?"
 - Essay must be one page, single spaced with included essay title
- Resume (*recommended not required*)

Please note: Only completed applications will be considered.

Application process:

- Application opens January 29, 2024.
- Application packet deadline: April 12, 2024, at 5:00 pm.
- Award recipients will be notified by May 10, 2024.
- Application packets can be submitted by **mail** or **email**.

Proof of enrollment and acceptance to an accredited institution in the academic year after your selection is required. Awards will be made payable to the accredited institution. Scholarship cannot be redeemed for cash or certified check.

Employees, interns, and employee family members are not eligible for this scholarship opportunity.

Awarded recipient must use the funds before March 2025.
